

Terms and conditions for Red Funnel Isle of Wight Literary Festival Write on Wight Prize Draw 2020

Publishing terms

1. Our prize draw is organised by The Isle of Wight Literary Festival (IWLF) of Northwood House, Ward Avenue, Cowes PO31 8AZ registered with the Charity Commission for England and Wales under number 1164814.

How to enter

2. Entries received after 18th September 2020 will not be accepted.
3. Our prize draws and competitions are free to enter and no purchase is necessary but is dependent on completing an entry for Write on Wight following the instructions on isleofwightliteraryfestival/write-on-wight
4. The IWLF will not accept responsibility for entries that are lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed in transit, regardless of cause, including, for example, as a result of any equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server, computer hardware or software failure of any kind.
5. By submitting an entry, you are agreeing to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. If you have any questions, please contact info@isleofwightliteraryfestival.com
6. IWLF reserves the right to refuse entry, or refuse to award the prize to anyone in breach of these terms and conditions.

Eligibility

7. Unless otherwise stated, our prize draw is open to all except IWLF Trustees, agents or any third party directly associated with administration of the prize draw.
8. Entrants under 18 must get consent from their parent(s) or legal guardian(s) before entering. The parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of entrants under 18 agree to these Terms and Conditions on behalf of the entrant.
9. Only one entry per person is permitted.
10. In entering, you confirm that you are eligible to do so and eligible to claim any prize you may win. The IWLF may require you to provide proof that you are eligible to enter the prize draw or competition.
11. The IWLF reserves all rights to disqualify you if your conduct is contrary to the spirit or intention of the Write on Wight submission and prize draw.

The Draw

12. Winners will be chosen by random draw performed by a computer process within one week of the competition ending.
13. Four prizes will be awarded to four separate individuals:
 - **2 x vouchers of £25 from Medina Books** that can be redeemed in shop in Cowes, or online.
 - **2 x car return tickets from Red Funnel.** Tickets will be valid for a return vehicle ferry crossing for up to 7 people (additional passenger rates available) in a car up to 5.5m length/2m height. The tickets are also available for a small van up to 5.5m length/2m height.
Conditions: Not valid with any other Red Funnel offer or concession, including standard Travel Card holder discounts. Valid for new bookings only. Red Funnel reserve the right to

withdraw this without prior notice. Standard conditions of carriage apply. The tickets will not be valid for travel between 17-21 June 2021, Saturdays in July and August & Christmas Day.

14. The winner will receive details of the prize. The winner will be notified by email or telephone (using details provided at entry) within 7 days of being chosen and must provide an email address. If a winner does not respond to IWLF within 7 days of being notified, then the winner's prize will be forfeited and the IWLF will be entitled to select another winner in accordance with the process described above.

15. Prizes will be available to the winner within 7 days of responding to IWLF.

16. The prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternative is offered. The IWLF reserves the right to replace the prize with an alternative prize of equal or higher value if circumstances beyond its control make it necessary to do so.

17. The decision of the IWLF regarding any aspect of the prize draw or competition is final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into about it.

18. The winner's name and county can be obtained by sending a stamped addressed envelope to Isle of Wight Literary Festival (IWLF) of Northwood House, Ward Avenue, Cowes PO31 8AZ within 60 of days after the date of the closing date of the prize draw.

19. The IWLF reserves the right to hold void, cancel, suspend, or amend the promotion where it becomes necessary to do so.

Limitation of liability

20. Insofar as is permitted by law, the IWLF, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the IWLF, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.

Data protection and publicity

21. The IWLF is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy and will only use your personal information in accordance with these Terms and Conditions and the IWLF's Privacy Policy

22. By entering, you agree that any personal information provided by you with your entry may be held and used by the IWLF or its agents and suppliers to administer the competition, as part of Write on Wight in 2020, and for promotional purposes for subsequent festivals.

Governing law

23. All our prize draws will be governed by English law and entrants to the prize draw submit to the jurisdiction of the English courts.
